The Companies and Intellectual Property Commission ("CIPC") has noted over the past years that the volume of non-application documents and e-mails to the various business rescue processing mailboxes have increased.

These mailboxes are processing mailbox meaning that ONLY applications that require CIPC processing may be submitted to them. The growth in other non-application documents and e-mails, e.g. minutes of meetings, general correspondence between parties, creditor reports, is severely hampering the ability of CIPC officials to extract the relevant email applications and process such timeously.

Therefore, the following applications and documents must be submitted to the indicated mailboxes:-
