



Requirements for application to the Thuthuka Bursary

- Ⓢ The learner must be African or Coloured
- Ⓢ The learner must be a South African Citizen
- Ⓢ The learner must obtain atleast 60% on Mathematics (5 or above on the NSC Scale of Achievement) **NOT MATHS LITERACY**
- Ⓢ The learner must be in Grd12 intending on studying B comm. Accounting

The Process of Awarding a Bursary

- Ⓢ The application must have met the above criteria
- Ⓢ The learner must have or be in the process of applying to one of the following tertiary institutions:
 - University of Johannesburg
 - University of Cape Town (Bachelor of Commrce code CB011)
 - Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University
 - North-West University (Mafikeng Campus)
 - Stellenbosch University
 - University of Pretoria
 - University of the Free State
 - University of KwaZulu Natal
 - University of Witwatersrand (WITS)
- Ⓢ Once the learner has met the above criteria they will be called in for testing
- Ⓢ Depending on the test results then the learner may be called in for an interview.

Once the learner has met all the above requirements and gone through the relevant test and interview only then will the bursary be provisionally awarded to the learner pending the final Grade 12 results.

The annual closing date for our bursary is the 30th of April for the following year.
